Check in:

Heating/Fireplace:

There are small cadet heaters in each room although we don't recommend using the upstairs heaters, even in winter it can get quite warm upstairs.

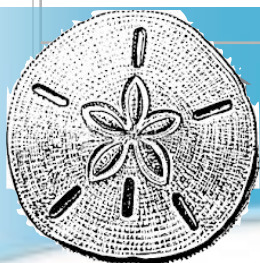
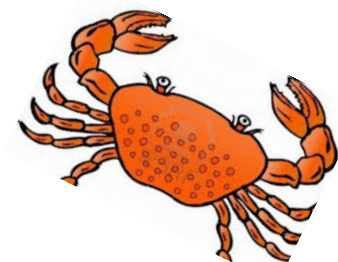
Please make sure the fireplace damper is open before use.

No Shoes Please:

Sand can be vacuumed up but the sap from trees tends to stick in the carpet. We appreciate you leaving shoes on the front porch.

Grocery:

There is a **Safeway** in Tillamook with everything you'll need. There is also a smaller market in downtown Netarts on Crab Ave called **Bayside Market & Deli**.

Sump Pump:

The wastewater system works off a sump pump in the downstairs utility closet. It will clog over time if anything but toilet tissue is flushed. No feminine products or wipes please. If for some reason the sump pump alarm goes off, switch it off and cease using water/toilets until the posted plumber is called.

Garbage:

The garbage dumpsters are located just outside the main gate to the left. You'll see a small access driveway.

Emergency:

In the event of a lockout you can call or visit the on property manager to let you back in.

There is a hospital in Tillamook (10 miles from us) with emergency services

Cell coverage is spotty but we have a landline you are welcome to use

The Beach can be accessed from the trail on the backside of the cottage. Its about a half mile walk down to the stairs and a few flights down to the beach. The beach is approximately 3.5 miles long and sits between the towns of Oceanside and Netarts. Perfect for a morning walk! You can also drive two minutes to the beach with ample public parking.

If you turn right at the bottom of the beach stairs you'll be heading to Oceanside where you can grab coffee or lunch at one of the two cafes in that tiny town. There is also a tunnel to access the other side of the beach. Watch the tides, but at low tide you'll see lots of sea life clinging to rocks on the other side of the beach. If you head left at the bottom of the stairs you'll soon reach the little community of Happy Camp where people crab fish from the shore.

The Ocean is quite cold at all times of year and suitable for only the heartiest swimmers (or those with a wetsuit). The Coast Guard is regularly plucking people out of dangerous surf so do be careful if you choose to wade or swim...the Oregon coast water can be rough and unforgiving.

Directions from Portland International Airport (PDX)

Your Drive will take you through the city of Portland and past the town Hillsboro as you make your way out of town. If you need a bathroom break before the drive through Tillamook National Forest, Hillsboro would be a good place to turn off for a quick stop.

The drive through the Tillamook forest is mostly two lanes and gorgeous. Its a bit twisty and we highly recommend you do not make this drive at night. Even in the Summer months there could be fog and the drive becomes more stressful than pleasant.

Once in Tillamook, the route will take you right by the Safeway in town. This is where you will want to pick up your groceries for the week. There is a tiny market in Netarts/Oceanside but it won't have nearly the selection as this Safeway.

Once you turn into the Capes use your card at the gate. Go through the first stop sign and continue on the main road. You will see a sign for "The Cottages". Ours is the first one you see after making the left turn. You may use the covered parking directly in front of the condo.

Inside the cottage:

You'll find linens and towels in the closet of the master bedroom and in the mudroom closet of the downstairs suite. There should also be towels in both bathrooms (check under sink downstairs)

The cottage should have plenty of laundry soap, dish-soap, toilet paper and shampoo/conditioner. There are hair dryers and straightening irons you may use.

There is wifi in the cottage. You will find the access code on the modem near the TV on the main floor.

Cell phone coverage is sketchy but there is a house phone.

There is a BBQ for your use in the carport closet. The key is in the kitchen drawer closest to the front door.

Garbage should be taken to the dumpster that sits just outside the main gate on the left.

Please no shoes in the cottage as the tree sap will ruin carpeting.



Bonfires on the beach are permitted and we have beach chairs in the downstairs closet. Feel free to grab a quilt from the cottage as well. You can find wood for your fire at the Safeway in Tillamook.



Please see the check out procedures on the flyer in the cottage. We will have the cottage professionally cleaned but we do ask that you secure the cottage with a few simple tasks.

Please take all of your garbage with you. There is a dumpster just outside the main gate on the left. Please empty the coffee filter, start the dishwasher no matter how small the load, please don't leave anything wet in the washer and please take all perishable foods with you. You may leave the dryer running if you there are towels or sheets to be dried. All blinds should be closed leaving 2" on the bottom (so they don't touch the windowsill). Please be sure all windows are closed. Finally, please leave a note if we are out of anything so we may stock the cottage for our next guest.
